ITINERARY

Day 1 * Arrival to Lima

We will be waiting for the group at Lima Airport - Transportation to Hotel 5* Hotel in Lima

Day 2 * Lima City Tour

Today we will have our Historical Lima City tour, we will visit the **Plaza de Armas**, which has been declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO, **Santo Domingo Convent**, oldest convent in Lima, **Casa Aliaga**, Colonial House in Lima built in 1535, the same year of Lima's foundation, ever since then, the Aliaga family and their descendants have lived in the house, now occupied by the seventeen generation of the same family. We will visit Larco Herrera Museum, a privately owned museum that hosts the most extensive collection of pre-Columbian art, housed in an 18th-century vice-royal building.

Overnight in Lima

Day 3 * Lima - Paso Horse Show

This morning, we drive south to enjoy a great Caballo de Paso Peruano show (Peruvian Paso horses) followed by lunch in a beautiful Hacienda.

We will come back to Lima after lunch.

Overnight in Lima

Day 4* Lima - Cusco - Urubamba

We will leave Lima to take our flight to Cusco, on our arrival to Cusco airport, we will be transported to Urubamba in Sacred Valley (9,420 ft above sea level)

Day 5 & 6 * Sacred Valley tour

We will spend the following two days visiting the beautiful Sacred Valley, we'll visit the village of **Pisac**, founded during colonial times, and set at the foot of a hill crowned by the remains of an ancient Inca city. We'll continue our visit to **Ollantaytambo**, the only Inca town that was not defeated by the Spanish with an opportunity to explore the ruins which tower above, and other interesting places in the area.

Overnight in Urubamba

Day 7 * Urubamba - Machu Picchu - Urubamba

We will start our day by taking an early morning train to Machu Picchu town, as soon as we arrive, we will take a bus to **Machu Picchu citadel** - the most famous and well-preserved Inca site of the Andean region. It sits on a mountain ridge above the Urubamba Valley (7,970 ft above sea level). In 1983, Machu Picchu was declared a **UNESCO World Heritage Site** and in 2007 was voted one of the New Seven Wonders of the World.

We will return to Urubamba (by train) after the visit Overnight in Urubamba

Day 8 * Urubamba – Cusco

We will leave the hotel this morning, we'll drive to **Cusco** (11,150 ft above sea level), the historic capital of the Inca Empire from the 13th until the 16th-century Spanish conquest. This beautiful colonial city was declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO In 1983.

We will have our Cusco City Tour this afternoon 5* HOTEL IN CUSCO

Day 9 * Cusco – city tour

We will continue touring the beautiful colonial city of Cusco Overnight in CUSCO

Day 10 * Cusco - Lima - USA

Morning at Leisure.

We will take an afternoon flight from Cusco to Lima, arriving at Lima International airport to connect with the international flight to USA.

End of the trip
